SoftGlue's Software Tools

Zip File Installation Instructions

Introduction:

All of SoftGlue's installations are contained within a compressed FileName.zip for redistribution to prevent installations form being wrongfully recognized by the operating system malware & virus guards such as Microsoft Windows Defender and others. All applications are both licensed by Visual Studio and Microsoft and all applications pass the rigorous compiler checks when they are compiled and run for the first time on the client computer that developed them.

Zip file installation has been around since the beginnings. However, with the advances and changing of the times, this form of general installation has been largely replaced by smarter & better forms of security compliance installation platforms. Unfortunately, there are problems with failing to download as unedified or as an unknown license source when downloaded from a remote server; such as SoftGlue's webhost of https://softglue.net.

SoftGlue's new zip file installation memory buffer API solves these installation problems, removing itself completely from disk once that installation has completed and disabling the application if the installation was not performed to the instructions of this document below telling the user to uninstall & try again.

Installation Instructions:

- 1) Download SoftGlue's installations only into the **C:\Users\username\Downloads** folder. This is a special folder that checks all installations for malware when it's downloaded, disabling it if any known malware or virus infections are found.
- 2) Either with the key board CTRL+C as copy and CTRL+V as past, right click the mouse and copy & paste, drag the installation file from the zip file to the Downloads folder or use the zip tools extraction function and paste the installation file into the same Downloads folder as the downloaded zip file.
- 3) Double click the installation file now in the Downloads folder to start it up within a few minutes after download. It will then extract its own working installation files and install the intended application and place an icon on the desktop, register the application with **Programs and Features** and delete both itself and the downloaded zip file, leaving no working installation files on disk, including the downloaded zip.
- 4) If the installation is not down correctly by either not starting it within a few minutes or if the installation is not performed per these instructions, it will not install completely disabling itself telling the user & telling the user to uninstall the application and download again and reinstall.

Note:

Do not start the installation form within the zip file. It may not install or may malware, disabling it. SoftGlue's installations are a security form of application installation as part of its own fight against malware and virus installation infections. All installations and runtime security messages you may receive have a real security maintenance purpose. **Thank you for choosing SoftGlue.**
